The Ohio State University Press begins publishing services for *The Journal of Race & Policy* in 2023

In 2023 the journals division of The Ohio State University Press will begin a partnership with the Consortium for Research on Race, Diversity & Policy to publish their journal, *The Journal of Race & Policy*. An annual publication, this journal will continue to appear in print but will also be published online on Project MUSE. The journal was founded by Professor Michael Clemons of Old Dominion University in 2004 with a mission “to bring to academia and policy makers perspectives and insights about race and ethnicity and their relevance to timely policy-related topics dealing with the state, region, nation, and the world.” Dr. Clemons continues to edit this journal along with Associate Editor Bertis English, of Alabama State University. The press looks forward to providing publishing services and opportunities that will enable the journal to reach new audiences and potential authors. Tony Sanfilippo, director of OSU Press, affirms that “adding this journal to our list will support the mission of the press to circulate the best of peer-reviewed humanities and social sciences scholarship globally. Articles in *The Journal of Race & Policy* will add nuance to and enrich important policy discussions happening today and tomorrow.”
