Beginning in 2025 *Victorians: A Journal of Culture and Literature* will be edited by Dr. Kristen Pond, Baylor University. Dr. Deborah Logan, Western Kentucky University, emerita, has been editor of the journal since 2008.

Dr. Logan reflects on the long history of the journal: "*The Victorian Newsletter* was established in 1952, a project that grew out of discussions by the MLA Victorian Group to address the need for networking resources in the field. From its first editor, Richard D. Altick, forward, *The Victorian Newsletter* has featured many of the most prominent Victorian studies scholars for over seventy years. The *Newsletter* initially devoted to publishing professional announcements and queries for research projects evolved into an academic journal of international stature, now with a presence on Project Muse. As editor, I have been honored to serve the Victorian scholarly community through *Victorians Journal.*"

Under Dr. Logan, the journal moved from under the publishing program of The Ohio State University Press and joined the Project MUSE premium collection, available in over 1300 libraries worldwide.
